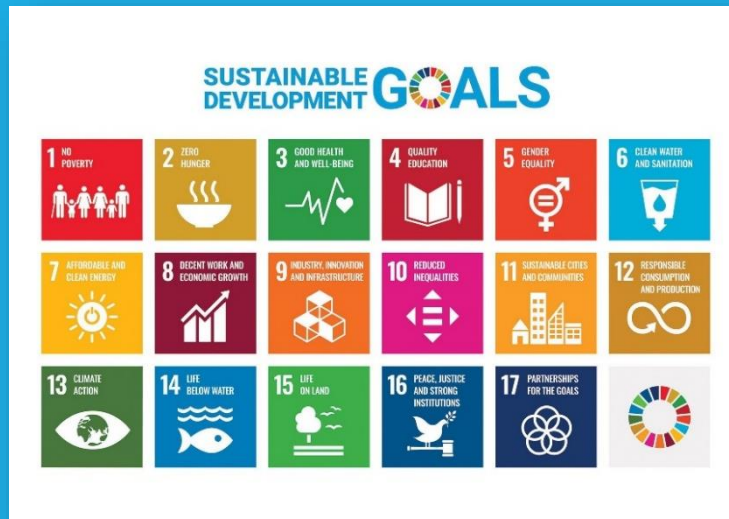

### **2024 Question:**

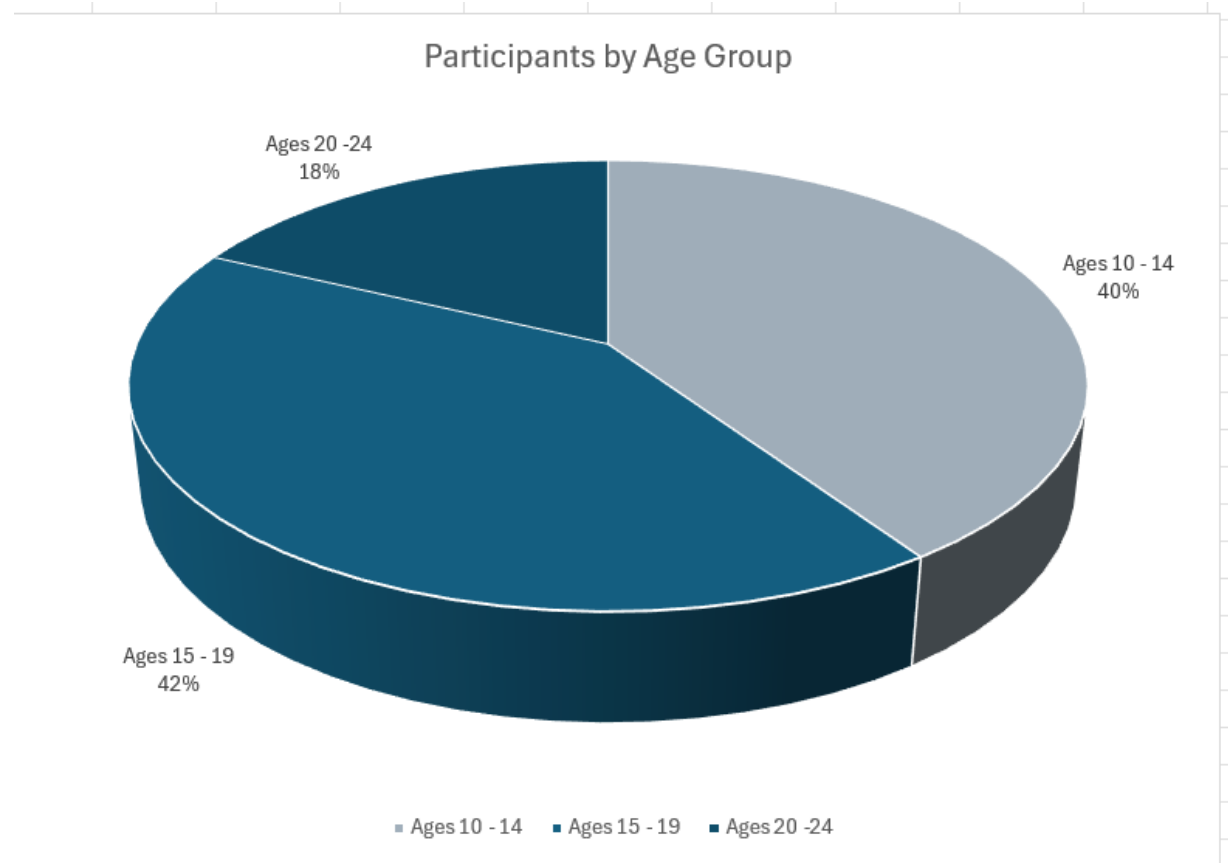
# Applications by Age



## Age Categories

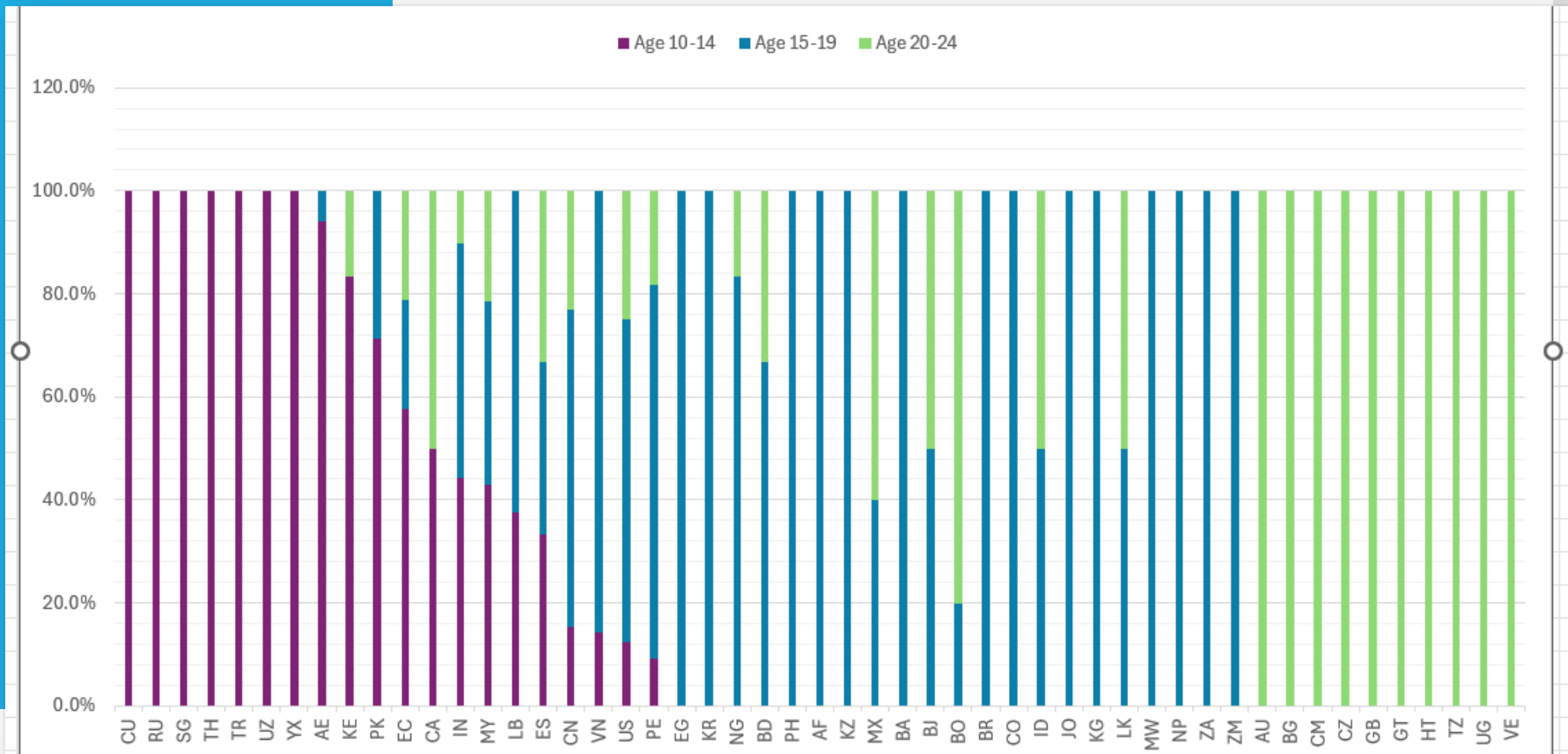
10-14, 15-19

# Ages and Counties

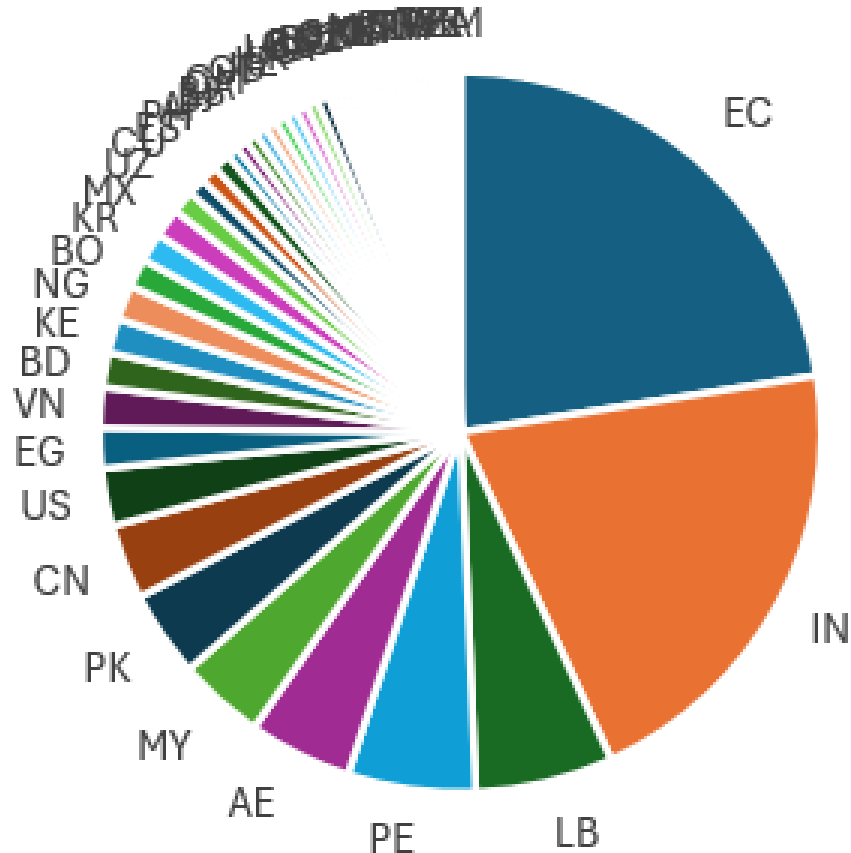
Ages in highest

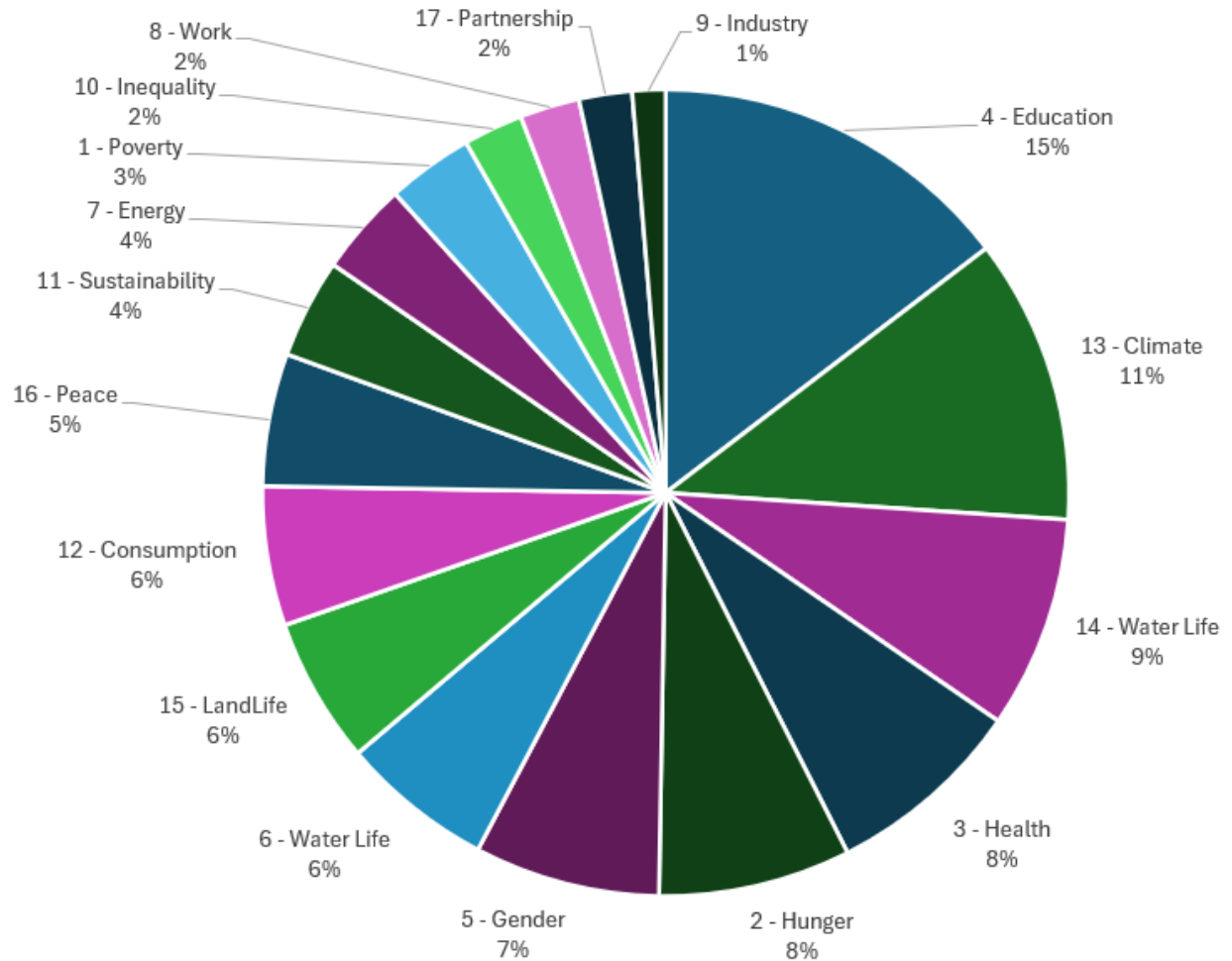
