As a Member State of UNESCO, the U.S. is eligible to host UNESCO clubs. These clubs take a variety of forms – depending by whom and under what circumstances they are created – and are able to tap into the global network of UNESCO clubs, as they wish.

UNESCO clubs, associations, and centers in the U.S. are not official U.S. government organizations; they and their members are responsible for their own activities.
